Calculate Total

- Residency Requirement:** at least half (50%) of the major requirements must be taken at York University
- Upper-level Requirement:** at least 36 credits at the 3000-4000 level. 18 credits must be at the 4000 level, including at least 12 credits in English
- 1700-1900/Pre-1700 Requirements:** Students must complete at least 6.0 credits from Time Period Group I and/or Time Period Group II

NOTE # 1: Eligibility Requirement: Students may enrol in English courses at various levels according to their year of study based on credits completed: Yr 1 = up to 23 credits; Yr 2 = 24-53 credits; Yr 3 = 54-83 credits; Yr 4 = 84 credits and above

NOTE #2: Non-Literature Courses: students cannot use uncategorized EN courses toward their major requirements; these include, but are not limited to, courses offered in the subjects PRWR, CRWR and DLLL

NOTE #3 Popular Genre Course: students may count up to a maximum of 6 credits from Category D (Popular Genres: EN 3170-3179) towards their major requirements.
